

Running ATS on a MAC

ATS may be run on a MAC in one of three ways:

1. The ATS Core may be run on a MAC with an Intel processor:
 - a. Running VMWare Fusion or Parallels with Windows 7* or newer installed. Links for both are below.
 - b. Running boot camp you may also partition the hard drive, install Windows 7* or newer, then install/run the ATS Core.

2. The ATS Core Portal may be run on any machine using an internet browser. This includes running Safari on a MAC. Using the ATS Core Portal you may do all of the day-to-day operations such as adding/viewing athlete info, entering injuries, entering/updating notes, checking out equipment, note medications given, check a team roster, enter/update rehabs, enter/update modalities and more.
3. The ATS Smartphone may be run on any machine using an internet browser. This includes running Safari on a MAC. Using the ATS Smartphone you may do many of the day-to-day operations such as adding/viewing athlete info, entering injuries, entering/updating notes, checking out equipment, note medications given, check a team roster, enter/update rehabs, enter/update modalities and more.

* Keffer Development Services does not provide the Windows operating system, or do any software installation on local machines for setting up a MAC.

Note: At least one user must run the ATS Core to perform Admin functions.
